

# Devine Lake and Mishonagon Creek State Natural Area

Sunday July 1, 2018.

Meet at the Kwik Trip at the Highway 70/51 intersection in ARBOR VITAE at 9am. Drive around the back of the building so we are out of the way.

Alternatively, meet at the put-in by 9:30: Go 2 miles north of Highway 70/51 intersection in ARBOR VITAE, turn left on North Farming Rd. Turn right on to Rux Rd at T junction and continue past Verna Lake to Reinert Rd. Turn left, away from Reinert Rd onto a gravel driveway (#s 2505 and 2503). After 0.1m turn right onto snowmobile trail. Continue on Snowmobile trail all the way to a gate, ~1mile. We will park there and take turns getting vehicles close to water for boat drop off. GPS coordinates: 45.984840, -89.731004.

It is going to be a lot of paddling in back channels. Very much a botanists' tour of a wetland complex. So wandering around looking at plants, not covering miles or racing to get somewhere.

Bring water, food, bug stuff, field guides, cameras, Sun protection, GPS if you want. Expect to get wet and muddy. We will be out there 3-5 hours.
